Course description

The course will follow part of the route of the International Event, from The Quarry to Huntsman Close via the Lake. All permanent pasture. While the fence dimensions are as for normal BE90/100 classes, the technical severity of the course as a whole is appropriate for Championships and the course is much longer than for a standard course (approximately 3,000m).
